Greetings, Friend.

Looking for a prudent and meaningful use of your resources when **Wall Street** investments are so questionable? The heart of Centers for Christian Study International (CCSI), the parent organization of Rivendell College, is bringing the resources of **Christian scholarship** and **Christian community** to secular universities in the United States and abroad. We offer Christian community through student residential facilities in former fraternities and sororities. And we offer Christian scholarship through academic courses taught by faculty who embrace the Christian worldview. This has proven to be a life-changing tandem for many students who struggle for their faith in the secular academy!

In the past we worked with Denver Seminary and then Northwestern College of Saint Paul, Minnesota in providing courses for credit. In 2005 God called us to begin making plans to launch our own private liberal arts college to serve as the academic arm of CCSI.

This has become Rivendell College, now in its second year in Boulder, Colorado. The College has been granted authorization from the state of Colorado to offer degrees, with the recognition that we have "demonstrated reasonable and timely progress towards accreditation." We are pursuing regional accreditation with the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association. The next step in the process is two-fold: an expanded self-study on our part, and a site visit from the accrediting agency. If we are successful in this, we will gain candidate status. Our anticipation is that this will happen during the 2009-2010 school year.

**Candidate status is extremely important for a start-up college!** Until we have it we are unable to offer any federal or state financial aid to students. That, in turn, impacts our ability to recruit students to the College, especially in these financially difficult times. It goes without

saying that students are not only vital to our mission; but tuition revenues are also vital for the sustainability and future of Rivendell College. This is foundational to our business plan.

That's what this Rivendell College investment opportunity is all about. Through the acquisition of the Bethany campus God has provided not only a wonderful facility for us, but the asset base and security for this investment project. If we are successful in this campaign, it will 1) help us meet financial requirements for candidate accreditation status, and 2) give us an in-house loan program for students until we gain candidate status. This investment opportunity is part of Rivendell's larger capital campaign, which includes donations, grants and naming opportunities.

The resources generated by the investment opportunity you will be reading about will help build Rivendell College, fulfill the mission of CCSI, and influence the lives of hundreds of students in Boulder, and thousands across the United States and abroad.

## NEW CAMPUS, NEW OPPORTUNITY!

Largely because of our 26-year presence in Boulder and commitments to student ministry at the University of Colorado and in the city of Boulder, when Bethany Baptist Church voted on October 5, 2008 to dissolve, it also voted to sell this beautiful campus and building just east of the University of Colorado, to CCSI, the parent organization of Rivendell College. CCSI paid the church's financial obligations in the sale price and received the remainder as a gift.

Why is this significant? Not only will this facility east of the CU campus provide office space, classrooms for Rivendell's graduate program, library, bookstore and a coffee shop, it has greatly increased our asset base. The equity in the building will play a key role in the Promissory Note described in this Prospectus. A first-position deed of trust on this property will secure the investment.

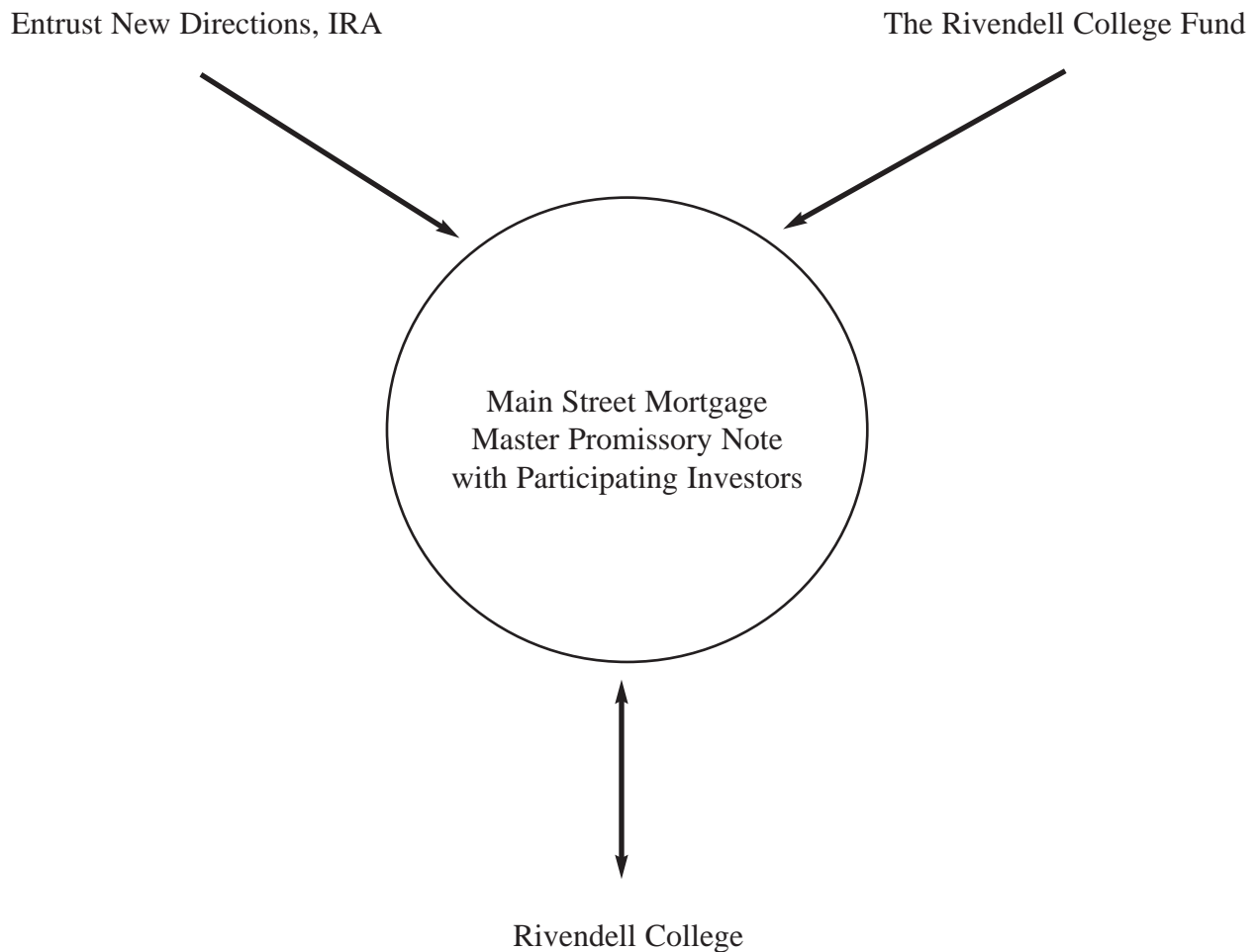

## Payment Options

Entrust New Direction, IRA. Investors who wish to roll over retirement plans and/or use self-directed IRA's may set up an account with Entrust, which will hold funds in escrow until the Promissory Note is executed.

All other investors will make payments to The Rivendell College Fund, which will hold funds in escrow until the Promissory Note is executed.

Investor funds will be returned in their entirety by July 31, 2009 if the minimum investment of \$1,300,000 is not reached by June 30, 2009.



**Investment Goal:** A minimum of \$1,300,000 and maximum of \$2,100,000.

**Offering Termination:** The termination date of this offering is June 30, 2009, unless terminated sooner by CCSI.

**Intended Use of Proceeds:** Financial assistance to Rivendell College in the pursuit of accreditation by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association, including a required liquid asset reserve fund, subsidy of Educational Assistance Loans for Rivendell College students, pay-off of first mortgage on 5495 Baseline Road, Boulder, Colorado, and subsidy of operating expenses as necessary.

- ◆ **Required liquid asset reserve fund.** This is the most urgent factor in moving the accreditation process forward for the College. Funds will be placed in a board-restricted, interest-bearing account. Documentation that this requirement has been met must be submitted to the accrediting agency before June 2, 2009.
- ◆ **The significance of gaining candidate accreditation status.** Before reaching the accreditation threshold of candidate status (representing substantial compliance with accreditation requirements), a college, while authorized to grant degrees, cannot offer federal or state financial aid to its students. This represents a significant handicap in recruiting students and a limitation on potential tuition revenues.

If this investment campaign is successful, it will put Rivendell College in a much stronger position to gain candidate accreditation status. The economic benefits of reaching this mile-stone are very substantial for the College.

- ◆ **The significance of a student-loan program prior to gaining candidate status.** The College currently loses qualified applicants because it is not yet eligible for federal and state financial aid. The ability to offer privately funded student loans will enable Rivendell College to enroll more students, which, in turn, will result in more program revenues (tuition and fees, room and board) to the College.

**Stimulus Bill and its Significance for Higher Education.** One of the major components of the economic stimulus bill signed into effect by President Obama is a substantial increase in federal Pell grants and federal student loans. Rivendell College stands to benefit from this development, which becomes available to our students when we gain candidate status accreditation with the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association.

**Investor Qualifications:** Investors must sign a statement that they believe they are a “sophisticated investor,” defined by the U.S. Securities Exchange Commission as having enough knowledge and experience in finance and business matters to evaluate the risks and merits of the investment, or be able to bear the investment's economic risk.

**Minimum Investment:** \$5,000.

**Amortization and Maturity Dates:** The Note will be repaid at interest rates, payment schedule and maturity dates, as described below.

Accrued interest-only payments will be made semi-annually on May 31 and November 30 with the exception of the first year of the offering, when interest will accrue and be paid on May 31.

Principal and any outstanding interest will be paid in full on investment maturity dates. *Major investors may negotiate Notes that are nuanced to their interests and needs.*

**Prepayment:** The Promissory Note may be prepaid in whole or in part at any time without premium or penalty. All prepayments shall first be applied to interest, and then to principal payments in the order of their maturity.

## **Investment Opportunities and Risks**

### **Opportunities:**

- ◆ A viable opportunity to provide an excellent liberal arts education that engages the mainstream academy with a Christian vision of life.
- ◆ The creativity and resources to capture, incorporate and utilize the “best practices” of online education, and, through it, to create a new paradigm of Christian higher education by providing the resources of Christian scholarship to students at secular universities in partnership with CCSI.
- ◆ The ability to attract world class Christian scholars and communicators who will influence large numbers of university students through Rivendell’s distance learning program and partnership with CCSI.
- ◆ The ability, through the leadership development program of Rivendell College, to equip a new generation of Christian leaders both on the Boulder campus and across the United States and abroad through Rivendell’s distance learning program and partnership with CCSI.

**Risks:**

- ◆ The Promissory Note described in this Prospectus will be secured by a first position Deed of Trust on the building and land at 5495 Baseline Road, Boulder, Colorado.
- ◆ Key-man life insurance and disability insurance, each in the amount of this Promissory Note, is being secured by CCSI for Rick Howe, the Founder and President of CCSI and Rivendell College, to protect these organizations and investors in the event of his death or disability.
- ◆ It is possible that Rivendell College will lose key personnel.
- ◆ It is possible that Rivendell College will not succeed in recruiting key personnel.
- ◆ It is possible that residential facilities that are currently leased will be sold or re-developed by owners, requiring Rivendell College to secure other facilities.
- ◆ It is possible that there may be future changes in Federal Financial Aid that negatively impact the College.
- ◆ It is possible that economic conditions in the United States may negatively impact the College.
- ◆ It is possible that Rivendell College will fail to meet goals in accreditation, student enrollment, and grants and contributions.
- ◆ Although the Maker of the Promissory Note will make every effort to limit risk to investors, for the reasons above and others unforeseen, it is possible to lose money in this investment.

**Payment of Principal and Interest****◆ Interest**

Monthly installments will be placed in an escrow account for semi-annual payments. Prior to distribution to students, funds will be in interest-bearing accounts, generating additional revenues for the College.

Interest on promissory notes to students (secured by parental signature) will be structured to generate additional revenues for the College.

Repayment of interest will be funded by greater net revenues from increased enrollment and student revenues in the 2009-2010 academic year made possible by private student loans funded by this investment campaign.

In 2010-2011 and following, repayment of interest will be funded by greater net revenues from increased enrollment and student revenues made possible by **federal student grants and loans.**

◆ **Principal**

Staggered maturity dates will distribute payments over a period of time.

A sinking fund will be created to set aside monthly installments to repay the principal amount of Notes at their maturity. This fund, along with interest payments, has been factored into the College's business plan. The sinking fund will generate interest income for the College.

Repayment of principal will be funded by greater net revenues from increased enrollment and student revenues in the 2009-2010 academic year made possible by private student loans funded by this investment campaign.

In 2010-2011 and following, payments on principal will be funded by greater net revenues from increased enrollment and student revenues made possible by **federal student grants and loans.**

Where a school is located says much about what kind of school it is, and likely will become.

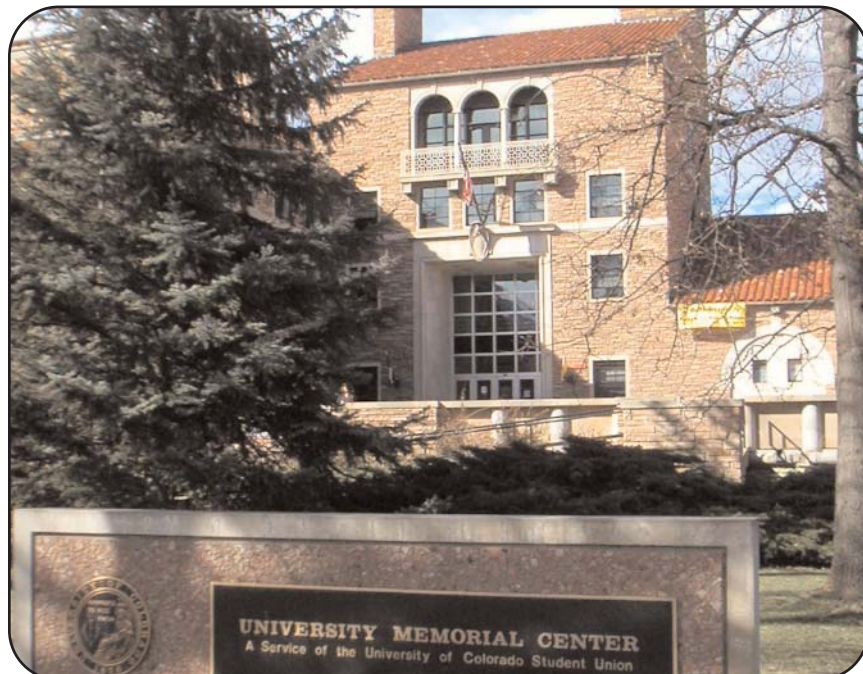

Rivendell College, by design, is situated in facilities bordering the University of Colorado, Boulder. We do not have a geographically distinct campus, but have chosen, rather, to weave our presence and programs into the fabric of the larger university community. Students live in former fraternities and sororities, and in apartments and houses among thousands of university students with many different backgrounds and beliefs. This real-world setting is essential to Rivendell's vision of education and life-formation.





As a learning community, Rivendell College is committed to the advancement of Christian scholarship and constructive engagement with the larger academic community and the ideas that shape minds and influence our society.

Rivendell classes are held in buildings adjacent to the University of Colorado campus. Rivendell students are encouraged to take at least one course at CU, and to interact with university campus life by participating in Christian campus ministries, using public facilities such as Norlin Library and the University Memorial Center, attending public university lectures and conferences, and enjoying university athletic, music, and theater events open to the public.

In turn, students, faculty and staff of the University of Colorado, Boulder are invited to enroll in Rivendell College classes and to participate in College events.

At Rivendell we embrace the classical vision of the university as a Christian institution. As heirs of that legacy, we believe that all truth is God's truth, and that every good gift is from God. This foundational conviction inspires us to engage in rigorous and thoughtful interaction with the brightest and best minds within and outside the Christian tradition.
